

Recognition of Foreign Engineering Degrees According to § 2 HIngG:

The Chamber of Engineers of Hesse offers the service to recognize your engineering degree acquired abroad also for Germany.

As part of the process, there will be a thorough assessment of the formal as well as the content requirements stated in § 2 HIngG. The following documents are requested for this examination:

- a signed cover letter
- a copy of the applicant's identity card or passport (stating full name, address, date of birth and validity. All other information can be blacked out.)
- a current certificate of registration (not older than seven days)
- [application form](#)
- a certified copy of your original diploma certificate (in its original language)
- a certified copy of the German translation of your diploma certificate
- a certified copy of your complete examination certificate (in its original language)
- a certified copy of the German translation of your complete examination certificate (proof of examinations or courses taken, including number of hours – usually called index, diploma supplement, Prüfungszeugnis, study record or similarly)
- a copy of your residence permit
- if available: certificate of study at a German university
- if available: certificate of attending a course of study at a German institution of higher education
- if available: identity card for displaced persons (registration document is not sufficient)
- if available: certificate of equivalence for foreign university qualifications
- if available: marriage certificate or proof of name change

The Chamber of Engineers of Hesse can issue certified copies where required. Please provide the original documents in such cases.
